

Tuition/Fee Increase Hardship Waiver Policy LSUA  
Fall 2010

1. Student must be admitted as a regular, degree seeking student by August 6, 2010 for the Fall 2010 semester.
2. Student must have completed the FAFSA and have submitted all required financial aid paperwork/documentation as indicated in the student's Net Partner Account by August 13, 2010.
3. Student must currently be in compliance with the Satisfactory Progress Policy or be a First Time Freshman.
4. Student must be enrolled in at least 12 credit hours by August 13, 2010. (Last regular orientation date) Students who drop below 12 hours of enrollment by the census day will have the waiver removed from their account.
5. Student must qualify as a Louisiana resident for fee assessment purposes.
6. Student can not be receiving any combination of university, private, state, or federally funded scholarship, award, tuition waiver, and/or grant that is equal to or exceeds the student's tuition and mandatory fees. Loans will not be considered for this calculation.
7. The amount of the waiver awarded a student will be based the difference in the student's aid as described in item 6 above and the student's tuition and mandatory fees. The maximum amount of the award will not exceed the dollar amount of the tuition increase for a full-time student of \$134.00.

Students will be required to submit an application. Applications will be emailed to the LSUA email address of students meeting enrollment criteria for the waiver. The waiver will be applied to all applicants for the tuition increase waiver who meet all criteria, until funds are exhausted. A maximum amount of \$10,000 is available to award in tuition hardship waivers. Funds available are budgeted in the hardship account. Students will be processed in date order according to the date applications are actually received by the Financial Aid Office.
