**Course ID:** Includes the abbreviated subject area and course number. Ex: ENGL 1001.

**Course Name:** These are abbreviated to fit available space. Students should consult the LSUA Catalog or the department responsible for the course if additional information is required.

**Course Section Number:** Course section numbers are 4 characters in length. The first character represents the term for the course. Section numbers starting with a "0" meet for the entire semester or summer term. Section numbers starting with an "A" or "B" (A01X, B01X, etc.) meet for half of the term. A-term is the first half of the semester and B-Term is the second half of the semester.

### The last character of the section number indicates the delivery method for the course as follows:

X - Normal delivery method. Face to face meetings with an instructor.

C - Compressed video. These courses will be conducted via video conference. Classes meet on campus through live, interactive television. The instructor may be on campus or at a remote campus.

T - Travel Course. These courses include a travel component and will typically be completed after the semester is over and travel is complete. The tuition only pays for the credit portion of the course. There are additional fees for the travel portion of the class. (See the appropriate department office for more information.)

I - Internet Course. Fully online course - delivered 100% electronically with **no** requirement to come to campus.

J - Electronic Delivery 75%. Substitutes 75% or more of class meetings with electronic delivery.

K - Electronic Delivery 50%. Substitutes 50% - 74% of class meetings with electronic delivery.




L - Electronic Delivery 25%. Hybrid-electronic course - substitutes 25% - 49% of class meetings with electronic delivery.

**Distance Learning (E-Learning):** Many courses use electronic methods to enhance the learning experience such as the Internet, CD or DVDs, or video tapes. Students enrolling in these courses should check the course fact sheet prior to enrolling to ensure they have access to the necessary resources to be successful in these courses. **Course Fact Sheets** can be found on the Distance Education website at <http://iet.lsua.edu/distanced/>. E-learning courses are designated in the schedule by the last character of the course section number as indicated above (Ex. 071I, 071J, 071K, 071L)
