Thank you for submitting the initial application fee for the pending radiography program sponsored by the Louisiana State University of Alexandria. Accreditation Assistant Timothy Ebrom, M.S. has been assigned to your program to assist you throughout the accreditation process.

The program is advised that the initial application and self-study report is now available and must be completed through the JRCERT's Accreditation Management System (AMS). To access the portal, go to the JRCERT website at <http://www.jrcert.org>. On the upper right side of the home page, you will see a tab entitled "AMS Portal Login," which will take you to the portal login page. Your portal username is the email address that this message has been sent. When you come to the AMS login page, click on "Forgot Your Password?" to change your password for the first time. You will receive an email that will take you to the Password Reset screen (you may need to check your Spam folder). Once you have changed your password, return to the login page, and sign in with your email address and new password.

It is important to note that there is a narrative character limit of 3,000 characters, only 15 Portable Document Format (PDF) files will be accepted by the portal, and all documents must be smaller than 20 MB in size.

Consistent with JRCERT policy if the initial application and self-study report has not been received by **February 19, 2026**, the program would need to contact the JRCERT prior to the due date to request an extension; otherwise, portal access will be removed. The program would again have to begin the initial accreditation process, including payment of the initial application fee. Please note that the accreditation process takes approximately 12 to 15 months to complete. Any delays in the submission of requested information may postpone the process.
