# **Overview:**

**Purpose** – As EPP stakeholders, employer satisfaction with our completers' impact and preparation in working with P-12 students is important. The EPP uses the survey data to ensure program impact and continued growth. Survey results also provide valuable information to the EPP about areas that need to be strengthened and the overall effectiveness of the program.

**Description** - Principals provided input on LSUA's completers teaching in their schools after one year of employment. They were asked to give feedback based on their observations and interactions with LSUA's completers and to give their perception of completer preparedness to teach effectively.
