# Other items of interest

- An OaKard is required to checkout materials.
- Schedule **instruction** with Rusty Gaspard or your library liaison.
- University **Archives** & Special Collections is on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of Bolton Library. The archivist, Michelle Riggs, provides instruction on primary sources and other history resources.
- A faculty-only **copier** is on the 1st floor. Ask your department's administrative assistant for your department's access code.
- Contact Rusty to **reserve** materials. A [form](#) is required.
- **Print books** are shelved in Dewey order. The reference collection, atlases, 800s, 900s, juvenile collection, and rare books are on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor. Other call numbers, Archives, & the oversize collection are on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor.
- **Print journal backfiles** are in storage. See Rusty for access.
