



## MLT Program Outcomes

The measure of our program's curriculum effectiveness is evaluated by collecting information from its students, graduates and the employers of our graduates. The following outcomes measures are used in the assessing the curriculum effectiveness of our program for the last three active years in accordance to the National Accrediting Agency for Clinical Laboratory Sciences (NAACLS).

- **ASCP BOC/ Equivalent Certification Pass Rate (Std. II.B.1):** NAACLS requires the last three active years of graduate certification rates to demonstrate an average of at least 75% certification rates from all examinations, for graduates who take the exam *within the first year of graduation*.
- **Graduation Rates (Std. II.B.2):** NAACLS requires the last three active years of results of graduation rates to demonstrate an average of at least 70% of students who have begun the final half of the program go on to successfully graduate from the program.
- **Placement Rates (Std. II.B.3):** NAACLS requires the last three active years of results of graduate placement rates to demonstrate an average of at least 70% of the respondent graduates either find employment in the field or a closely related field (for those who seek employment) or continue their education within one year of graduation.
