## WHAT TO DO NOW?

- Check the documentation page for any missing or incomplete documentation requested and submit that to the financial aid office
- Read the messages under the documentation section
- Monitor the accept awards tab for upcoming awarded aid for you to accept or decline.
- Monitor your LSUA and FAFSA email for additional requested information or notices
- Complete your LSUA admissions application if you have not already done so by clicking [HERE](#).
- This FAFSA is applicable beginning:
  - Fall 2022 for on campus students
- Please note this is now the default year. To see current or prior years' information you must change the year, see below for instructions on doing so.
- TOPS will not begin being awarded until after July 1<sup>st</sup> for first time freshmen.

## SPRING & SUMMER STUDENTS

- If you are enrolled in [Spring 2022 or Summer 2022](#) you will need to view the **2021-2022 Netpartner** to see documentation needed, messages, accept/decline aid, etc., for those terms.
  - To change the year find the drop down box at the top of the page
  - Select it and choose "2021-2022" from the drop down box, click on it
  - Check your messages and documentation
