The following is a list of items we suggest having in your residence hall room. It is only a suggestion -- you may bring more than this, but keep in mind the space limitations of a residence hall room (especially when shared with a roommate).

- Alarm Clock

- Shower Shoes

- Mattress Pad/Topper

- Computer/Printer
- Bed Risers (no cinder blocks)
- Toiletries
- Bottled Water
- Prescriptions
- Umbrella
- Surge Protectors
- Health/S.S. Cards
- Raincoat
- Calendar/Organizer
- School Supplies
- Desk Lamp
- Glasses/Flatware/Microwavable bowl
- Trash Can
- Television (Cable TV service is provided by the College) *Students will need to provide coaxial cable

What Not to Bring for Use in Your Room.

LSUA's Department of Residential Life takes fire safety seriously; therefore, the use of the following items in student rooms is not permitted: ***clothing irons, coffee makers with hot plates (Keurigs are acceptable), and heated styling tools.*** **These items can be used in common areas such as kitchens and bathroom.**

The following prohibited items will be confiscated and disciplinary action will be taken if found in the residence halls:

- Electric blankets
- Popcorn poppers Grill, propane, flammable liquid, charcoal
- Neon lights, paper lights, or Christmas/string lights
- Electric heaters/air conditioners (must be approved by Disabilities Coordinator)
- Candles (including for decoration), incense, and items carrying a live flame
- Duct tape**Items posted with duct tape will result in damage billing fine
- Pets (except fish in ten gallon tanks or less)
- Weapons and projectile devices including dart boards, pellet guns, foam dart guns, etc.
- Two-prong extension cords
- Multi-plug extension cords without surge protection
- Additional furniture (e.g. couches, recliners, small foam furniture, hammocks, tables > 2'x2')
- Real plants larger than 3 feet
