- Provide a letter of recommendation from a faculty or staff member
- Approval and Signature of academic advisor
- Mentors must be responsible, reliable, helpful, and capable of maintaining confidentiality and punctuality. We try to match SPERO students with mentors based on their shared interests.
- Attend scheduled meetings and participate in activities with SPERO students
- Attend Mentor Orientation at the beginning of first semester
